Section 1 - SUBORDINATE (Booths)

Entrance Fee \$10.00

Booth Size 8'x8' (Electricity will be furnished for booths by the Society)

Work on Grange booths may start at noon, Sunday, July 13. All entries must stay until 6:30 p.m. Sunday of fair week. Exhibits must be in place and completed Sunday at 9 p.m. with fence secured. All granges wishing to

exhibit must file entries with the Supt. on or before July 7th. Theme will be "Grange Support". Judging of grange booths will be in charge of superintendent.

Exhibits will be judged Monday

Grange Booths will be scored as follows:

Education 40% Adherence to topic 20% Workmanship 20% and Originality 20%

PRIZES

Exhibits scoring 75 points or over - \$100.00

Exhibits scoring between 60 and 75 points - \$75.00

Additional prizes as follow

First Place - \$35.00 Second Place - \$25.00 Third Place - \$15.00

Section 2 - JUNIOR GRANGE

Each Junior Grange will choose a different area of Jr. Grange program and will develop booth accordingly. No Entrance Fee. All Junior Granges must file their intention to exhibit with Superintendent. on or before July 7th. Judging of Jr. Grange booths will be in charge of the Superintendent.

The awards will be based on the decision of the judges according to the scale of points listed below. Highest possible score being 100.

SCALE OF POINTS

Education - 40%

Adherence to theme - 20%

Workmanship - 20%

Originality - 20%

Junior Granges making a worthy exhibit, scoring at least 65 points will be awarded \$75.00, and between 60 and 65 points \$60.00. Additional prizes as follows: First Place \$35.00, Second Place \$25.00 and Third Place \$15.00.

Junior Exhibits should be the work of the Junior members under the supervision of Junior Leaders appointed by the Grange. Work to be done before fair and can be set up by the Grange Jr. Committee or leaders.
