1. Exhibitors in this department are required to follow the Livestock Health Requirements.
2. All swine in purebred classes must be registered and the exhibitors must be able to furnish certificates of registry when requested.
3. Entries in class 6 cannot compete in other classes.
4. Swine entered in breeding classes may not be shown in market classes. Swine entered in market classes maynot be shown in breeding classes.
